PERSONAL EQUIPMENT LIST

LABEL EVERYTHING WITH YOUR NAME IN PERMANENT MARKER

SENTED PRODUCTS- do not use such products they attract biting insects like **MOSQUITOS**
Use the following personal gear checklist to ensure a good camping experience.

SHELTER –

For Base Camp - A good quality tent with a full fly that reaches the ground and out beyond the base of the tent. Cover this with a large tarp to ensure dry sleeping. Usually provided by troop

For Field Camp - Due to the threat of West Nile we **STRONGLY** recommend you bring a small light tent” for sleeping protection on the hikes. Ground sheet & plastic tent fly c/w stakes & rope

SLEEPING

__ **Field**-Sleeping bag light weight synthetic good to 0°C

__ ‘Blue foamy’ sleeping pad for backpacking

__ **Base**- Sleeping bag, liner & Blanket and Pillow –(-Air mattress or cot) for base camp only

COOKING

__ Fork, Knife, Spoon, Plate, Bowl & Cup suitable for hot or cold, in a “Ditty-Bag”.

__ an eye dropper bottle of Bleach to purify water with. (see sheet on purifying drinking water with Bleach)

__ A 1 pint cup, can, or pot with a wire handle c/w a chain dog leash to hang pot over fire.

__ Field meals & trail mix etc. in individual packages (Provided by troop)

__ 3-1 liter **largemouth** water bottles, ----- (Water Flavoring Provided)

CLOTHES “NOTE” Dark clothes attract Mosquito’s

__ * Scout Uniform (a MUST)

__ **Rain jacket & pants, rubber boots (a MUST)**

__ 6-7 Complete change(s) of clothes inc. shorts

__ 2 Sweatshirts with hood

__ Lightweight toque & neck warmer

__ Hiking boots or high top runners

__ Old runners or canoe shoe for canoeing & swimming

__ In-Camp footwear (**No flipflops**)

__ 2 Swim suits

__ Extra underwear

__ Lots of socks, varying weights

__ Jacket

__ PJ’s or sweat suit or long johns

__ Warm Coat

PERSONAL * As needed for Backpack and Base

__ Comb/brush & mirror

__ soap & deodorant “scent free”

__ Toothbrush & paste

__ Facecloth, Towels (hand & beach)

__ SUNSCREEN "scent free"

__ MOSQUITO REPELLANT

__ Toilet paper in a Zip-Loc bag

__ Garden trowel to dig toilet cat hole

__ hand sanitizer

__ Medicine (take only amount needed on trip leave remainder with Scouter for safe keeping)

No aerosol products please

OTHER

__ Backpack with HIPBELT 60 – 80 liter

__ Pocket knife (lock blade) with permit

__ Large Orange Garbage Bags to line Backpack with to keep items in pack dry

__ Pocket survival kit

__ Pocket first aid kit

__ Notebook & pencil

__ watch

__ Day pack (Red Stage)

__ 2 Flashlight & batteries

* Field book for scouting

__ Sewing Kit

* corn starch in Ziploc (rashes)

__ Matches in waterproof container

__ “Bic” type lighter

__ Zip-Loc Bags

__ Sun Glasses

- Mole skin

__ Silva #7 compass

__ Small Roll Duct Tape

__ Lawn chair

__ **Life jacket one that fits is Mandatory “This is a Canadian Law Requirement”**

OPTIONAL

__ Cell Phone (emergency & Pictures)

__ Extra battery pack or solar charger
